Program Information & Goals

The goal of the program is to motivate, inform and prepare students to transfer from a California community college to selective Top Tier Research institutions such as UCLA. Students in the program have access to our summer or fall and year-long academic preparatory transfer programs which guide students through the community college experience, the application and admissions process, research and pre-graduate opportunities, and career exploration. CCCP Scholars have a higher rate of admission to selective institutions and are eligible for special scholarships. The program is grounded on academic excellence, social justice, critical race theory and educational equity.

Target Part!cipants

CCCP targets students who can most benefit from a student-centered and social justice grounded program focusing on educational equity.

CCCP Scholars may:

- be the first in their family to go to college
- come from low-income backgrounds
- may be non-traditional students who have faced challenges in their academic career
- come from underserved communities
- have recently graduated from high school and plan to enroll in a community college in the fall OR students currently attending community college who have not yet completed a transfer curriculum at the time of application
- Be part of California's higher education equity plans

Program Requirements: (Subject to change)

- 1. One-year commitment starting summer OR fall 21 through spring 22.
- 2. Attend one of the required summer 21 or fall SITE LITE activities.
- 3. Attend at least one CCCP sponsored activity each quarter.
- 4. Make at least one contact with a peer advisor each quarter.
- 5. Maintain enrollment at a California Community College.
- 6. Research and apply for at least one scholarship.
- 7. Maintain and update contact information: address, current community college, telephone and e-mail address.
- 8. Report academic and transfer progress each semester enrolled at a community college through UC TAP updates.
- 9. Complete a program entrance survey in the summer and a program exit survey at the end of the spring.
- 10. If admitted and enrolled at UCLA, engage with CCCP and campus partners in enhancing UCLA's transfer receptive culture.

SUMMER INTENSIVE TRANSFER EXPERIENCE PLUS (SITE+)

Dates: June 14-July 30 **Deadline: CLOSED**

Six-week virtual program; students complete a UCLA summer sessions course, and receive individual advising on the UC application and personal insight questions. Introduction to research, university writing and support programs. Must participate in activities on Tues. and Thurs. from 2PM-5PM, and

- UNITS: 30+ Transferable Units
- English Comp completed by spring 21
- Transfer Math completed by spring 22
- Transferring Fall 2022
- Major prep in progress

POWER 2 THE TRANSFER WEBINARS (P2TT-W)

Dates: June 15-August 30 **Deadline: CLOSED**

Webinar series open to any student planning to enroll in a California community college in Fall 2021 with the goal of providing resources for multiple communities including a look at different educational pipelines, strategies to improve transfer opportunities and a critical context to understand the role of community colleges in California. Participate in at least one webinar.

Ability to benefit from program and included in UC/UCLA and California Community Colleges equity efforts/plans

Webinar links will be provided to students who complete the application process, are selected and confirmed to participate.

FALL 21 SITE LITE

Dates: September 8-December 17 Deadline: Open until capacity is reached.

Virtual/in person or hybrid activities that will introduce the UCLA • Open to students mainly enrolled at our CCCP Scholars Program, provide transfer resources, look at multiple transfer educational pipelines, and a critical context to understand the role of community colleges in California. Students will be introduced to transfer requirements and preparation, tips for success at their community college(s), and social justice using a Critical Race Theory in Education Framework.

HOW TO APPLY:

- 1. Review requirements and select a summer program
- Complete online application at www.cccp.ucla.edu (for SITE PLUS, there are also four essays)
- Complete the UC Transfer Planner for SITE Plus:
 - All courses/grades up to fall 20
 - Current courses spring 21
 - List your first & second UCLA Summer Course Choices in summer 21

Or for Power to the Transfer Webinars (P2TT-W)/Fall 21 SITE LITE

Create a UC Transfer Planner account

Students must be residents of California or the US (including AB 540/ undocumented students). International students who hold a current US Visa (F1 or other visa) are not eligible.

NOTE FOR RETURNING **SCHOLARS:**

CCCP prioritizes returning scholars for the 21-22 cohort if:

- Met satisfactorily current/former year requirements
- Complete CCCP application by deadline
- Update UC TAP information

All returning scholars can apply to SITE LITE but must meet stated requirements.
